# Thank You to Corporate Leadership Giving

The 2016 campaign theme was Be The One. This is true, it just takes one. One resident, volunteer, employee, or company leader, came together and helped us achieve our 2016 campaign goal of \$1,325,000 and delivered a positive impact in the community. This continued support allows for every day impact. This would not be possible without the loyal and compassionate donors who continue to support the Shelby County United Way.

During 2016, the Shelby County United Way supported 27 partner agency programs. In the fall, Character Playbook-Building Healthy Relationships was launched and facilitated in all 8 public middle schools in the county. The web based curriculum was built by EVERFI for United Way Worldwide and the NFL. Students participate in real life scenarios focusing on Analyzing Influences, Understanding and Managing Emotions, Communicating Effectively, Resolving Conflicts, Stepping In, and Making Decisions. In the first school year, 889 students participated completing over 4,606 modules.

In 2017, 211 was launched. Residents in the county now have access to a 24 hour a day information and referral service with a call center that is crisis trained. In the first three months we have averaged over 3 calls a day and expect that number to rise. Residents are getting more accurate and timely information, and do not have to wait for business hours of agencies to open.

We continue to evaluate agency programming during the allocation process to ensure United Way dollars are being invested for the greatest outcomes. We collaborate with our elected and civic leaders to discuss and evaluate our community's greatest concerns.

I would like to thank the 218 companies and corporate leaders that supported the campaign with a corporate gift and the many companies that coordinated a workplace campaign, to allow their employees to participate.

Shelby County is a great place to live because We're Better Together.
